Sealed tenders are invited from firms (on official letter heads) duly filled in Annexure - I & II for the Computer Education services from registered, reputed, experienced and eligible firms who have executed similar nature of work in Schools/ Institutions/ Organizations/ Government and satisfying all the terms and conditions in this tender document.

**1.0 Instructions to Tenders**

- 1.1 Tenders are invited in two bid system:(i) Techno-Commercial Bid (ii) Price Bid. The 'Techno-commercial Bid' will be made and put in the first envelope containing the title '**Techno-commercial Bid**' it should contain full information as required in Annexure - I. The 'Price Bid' will be made and put in the second envelope containing the title '**Price Bid**'. It could include full information as required in Annexure - II. Both bids should be put in the third envelope which should be prominently super-scribed as "**TENDERS FOR PROVIDING COMPUTER EDUCATION SERVICES**" and addressed to "The Principal, Jawahar Vidya Mandir, Shyamali colony, Ranchi - 834002" on or before 07/04/2026 till 12.30 PM. The tenders will be opened on the same date at 1.00 PM on 07/04/2026.
- 1.2 Tenders received after due date and time mentioned above, as well as those received without separate sealed envelopes as specified above will not be accepted.
- 1.3 It may be noted that conditional tenders or tenders incomplete in any respect will not be accepted.

QCBS qualifying marks will be 40. The bidders scoring 40 marks and above will be considered for final evaluation

### 5.0 Final Evaluation

Final evaluation would be done using Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS). An overall score will be calculated based on the Technical 60% and Financial 40 % score based on the following method.

$$\text{WtgTech} = 0.60$$

$$\text{WtgFin} = 0.40$$

Bn = Overall score of bidder under consideration

Tb = Absolute Technical score for the bidder under consideration

Fn = Normalized Financial score of the bidder under consideration

$\text{Fn} = \text{LF}/\text{BF} * 100$  where LF – Lowest Fee quoted in the Tender, BF – Bidder Fee quoted

$$\text{Bn} = (\text{WtgTech} * \text{Tb}) + (\text{WtgFin} * \text{Fn})$$

Core Formula

Overall score (Bn) = (Normalized Technical Score \* Technical Weight) + (Normalized Financial Score \* Financial Weight).

Key Steps & Formulas

1. Normalize Technical Score (Tn): (Bidder's Technical Score / Highest Technical Score) \* 100.
2. Normalize Financial Score (Fn): (Lowest Commercial Price / Bidder's Commercial Price) \* 100.
3. The highest combined scored agency will be awarded the contract



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**5.1 NOTE FOR EVALUATION**

- The Normalize Technical Score (Tn), Normalize Financial Score (Fn) & Evaluated Overall Score (Bn) shall be considered up to two decimal places.
- Contract shall be awarded to the bidder with the highest Evaluated Overall Score (Bn).
- In the event of two or more bids having the same highest Evaluated Overall Score (Bn), the bid scoring the highest marks against 'Technical' score will be recommended for award of contract. Even if there is a tie, 'draw of lots' will be resorted to arrive at the recommended bidder.

**6.0 Tender Fee & Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)**

The tenders should be accompanied by Cost of tender Documents i.e Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand) and Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 75,000/- (Rupees seventy five thousands only) in the forms of Account Payee Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque from any of the Commercial banks in an acceptable form, drawn in favour of "Jawahar Vidya Mandir", without which the tenders will not be considered. **The Earnest Money (EMD) only will be returned to all the tenderers after finalization of the contract.**

**8.0 Minimum Technical Specification and Scope of Work**

**8.1 Introduction:**

Jawahar Vidya Mandir (JVM), Shyamali, Ranchi is a reputed CBSE-affiliated senior secondary at Ranchi, Jharkhand. To provide quality education and promote the overall intellectual and technological development of its students, JVM invites sealed tenders from eligible and reputed agencies for providing comprehensive computer education services at the school, as detailed in this tender document.

**8.2 Scope of Work:**

Following are minimum scope of supply & services to be provided by the successful bidder:

- 8.2.1 The bidder shall undertake the supply, installation, configuration, operation, and maintenance of required hardware and software, and provide qualified manpower for imparting computer education, as specified in this technical specification and subsequent clauses of the tender document.
- 8.2.2 A duly signed copy of the Technical Specifications and Scope of Work shall be submitted by the bidder as a token of acceptance.
- 8.2.3 All hardware supplied under the contract shall be covered under Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (CAMC) support for the entire duration of the contract.
- 8.2.4 The duration of the contract shall be as specified in Clause No. 16 (Period of Contract) of this tender document.
- 8.2.5 The bidder shall be responsible for the supply, installation, configuration, and Comprehensive Annual Maintenance (CAMC) of all networking equipment required for establishing and maintaining internal LAN connectivity within the computer laboratory.
- 8.2.6 The bidder shall ensure the availability of adequate spare parts and technical support to ensure uninterrupted CAMC services during the entire contract period.

- 8.2.7 Upon completion or termination of the contract, all hardware and software supplied under the contract shall be handed over to the purchaser in good working condition, subject to normal wear and tear.
- 8.2.8 The bidder shall provide computer education to all students of Classes IV to X at Jawahar Vidya Mandir, Shyamali, Ranchi.
- 8.2.9 The syllabus and curriculum shall be in accordance with CBSE guidelines and shall be approved by the school authority prior to the commencement of each academic session.
- 8.2.10 The bidder shall deploy a minimum of four (04) full-time computer faculty members and one (01) full-time Lab Instructor for conducting computer education classes and managing the computer laboratory.
- 8.2.11 All deployed faculty members and Lab Instructor shall adhere to the school timing, rules, and academic schedule as prescribed by the school authority.
- 8.2.12 The bidder shall supply, install, and maintain a minimum of 40 (forty) desktop computer systems, as specified in the Minimum Requirement Summary (BoQ)- clause no. 10 with the minimum configuration as indicated in Minimum Technical Specification of Desktops systems (Clause no. 9). The desktop systems shall be supplied with only licensed/ open-source software and paid antivirus solution.
- 8.2.13 The bidder shall also provide necessary furniture for computer systems and infrastructure required for internal networking within the computer laboratory.
- 8.2.14 The bidder shall provide hardware maintenance support for all installed computer systems, networking equipment, and UPS systems throughout the contract period. In case of hardware failure requiring replacement of parts, the bidder shall rectify the fault or replace the defective component within the time duration defined in the SLA clause and without any additional cost to the purchaser.
- 8.2.15 The bidder shall print question papers for terminal examinations of the computer subject, conduct evaluation/correction, submit the marks to the school authority, and update the results in the ERP system provided by the school.
- 8.2.16 Data Security and System Integrity:  
The bidder shall ensure that all computer systems, software, and networking infrastructure installed under this contract are secure and protected from unauthorized access, malware, or misuse. The bidder shall be responsible for installing and maintaining updated antivirus software and implementing necessary security measures to safeguard the systems and data used in the computer laboratory.
- 8.2.17 Faculty Availability and Replacement:  
The bidder shall ensure continuous availability of the deployed computer faculty and lab instructor during school working hours. In the event of leave, resignation, or absence of any faculty member, the bidder shall arrange for a suitable replacement so that academic activities are not disrupted. SLA shall be applicable for Faculty Availability and Replacement.

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**8.2.18 System Availability and Uptime:**

The bidder shall ensure that the computer laboratory infrastructure, including desktop systems, networking equipment, and UPS systems, remains operational and available for use during school hours. Any system failure shall be attended promptly in accordance with the service level requirements specified in the tender document.

**8.2.19 Compliance with School Policies:**

All personnel deployed by the bidder shall strictly adhere to the rules, discipline, safety requirements, and academic policies of the school. The school reserves the right to request replacement of any personnel whose conduct or performance is found unsatisfactory.

**8.2.20 Service Level and Penalty for Non-Availability:**

The bidder shall ensure uninterrupted academic services and proper functioning of the computer laboratory infrastructure. In case of non-availability of faculty, prolonged system downtime, or failure to meet service levels specified in this tender, the school reserves the right to impose penalties as per the Service Level Agreement (SLA) or take appropriate corrective action including termination of the contract in case of repeated violations.

- In the event that the cumulative penalties exceed the above limit or in case of repeated failure to meet the SLA requirements, the school reserves the right to take appropriate action, including issuing warning notices, withholding payments, or termination of the contract, as deemed necessary.

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#### **14.0 SLA Exclusions**

The time lost due to any of the following causes shall not be included in calculating “System Availability” or “Resolution Time”:

- a) Force Majeure Events: Any failure or delay in service caused by events beyond the control of the vendor, including but not limited to natural disasters, wars, civil disturbances, strikes.
- b) Planned Maintenance Downtime: Scheduled maintenance activities or upgrades that have been pre-approved and communicated in advance (at least 48 hours prior) to the client.
- c) Purchaser & OEM Dependent Actions or Delays: Time taken for inputs/ approvals/Supply OEM dependencies.

#### **15.0 Payment Terms:**

The payment will be made on quarterly basis after completion of each quarter after deducting penalties (if any) as indicated in the SLA clause.

15.0.1 The minimum number of students for Classes IV to X for shall be considered is **2,538** for session 2026-27(excluding 112 BPL students).

15.0.2 The computer education service shall be provided to the BPL students also without any additional commercial implication to the purchaser. The number of BPL students may vary during the contract period.

15.0.3 During the contract period of 05 (five) years, in the event of an increase in student strength of up to 10%, the agency shall continue to provide computer education to all the students from Classes IV to X without any additional cost implication to the purchaser. However, if the student strength exceeds the estimate by more than 10%, payment shall be made as per actual no. of students and the bidder shall deploy additional computer faculty member(s).

#### **16.0 PERIOD OF CONTRACT**

The period of the contract shall be 05 (five) academic years from the date of commencement of the contract. The performance of the bidder shall be reviewed annually. In the event that the services are found to be unsatisfactory, as communicated or recorded by the school, or for any other reason deemed appropriate by the school authority, the contract may be terminated at any time by giving \*\*90 (ninety) days' prior notice.

#### **17.0 Special Terms and Conditions**

- 17.1 The School will provide Classrooms and Electrical power only.
- 17.2 Tenderer shall be responsible for regular conduction of Theory and Practical classes as per the routine of the school.
- 17.3 Faculty will explicitly follow the rules and regulation of the school in conducting tests and awarding marks/grades to the students.
- 17.4 The faculty will report to the school as per school timing for taking classes. The working time and holiday will be as per schools norms.

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- 17.6 TENDERER should get approval of the syllabus/courses from the school before the commencement of the session.
- 17.7 TENDERER should depute minimum four (4) regular computer faculties and one (1) Lab. Instructor in the beginning of session. Tenderer has to submit attendance, PF/ESI record of its deputed four (4) regular computer faculties and one (1) Lab. Instructor, every quarter.
- 17.8 TENDERER should arrange alternate teacher in case of leave by deputed teacher.

**18.0 Performance Guarantee (Security Deposit)**

The successful bidder shall give Performance Guarantee (Security Deposit) of 3% of total contract value in the form of Bank Guarantee from a Commercial Bank in favour of "Jawahar Vidya Mandir". The Bank Guarantee will be returned only after the expiry of the contract. The Bank Guarantee is liable to be forfeited, if during the period of contract the services of the contractor are found to be unsatisfactory in any respect, and / or if any of the conditions of the contract is contravened / breached, by the firm / or his employees. The forfeiture will be in addition to any action by the school that the contractor firm may invite upon themselves due to any of the reasons specified above.
